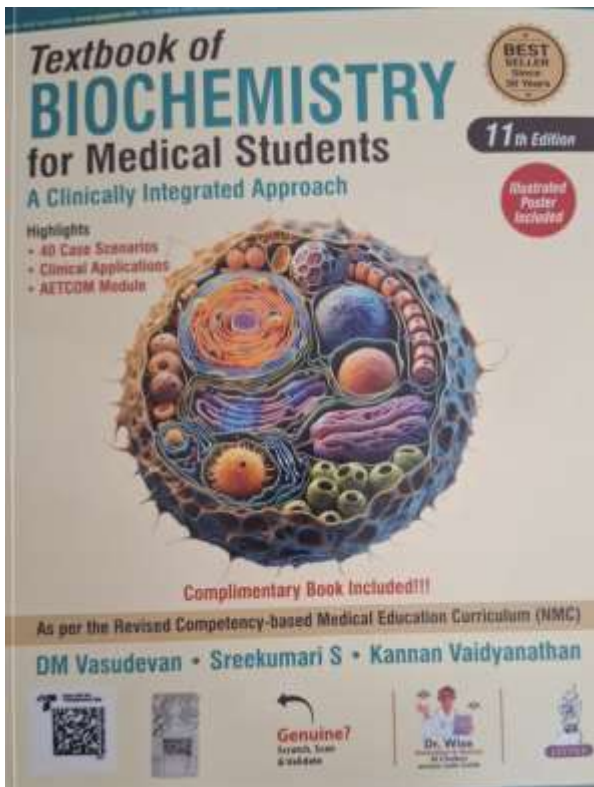

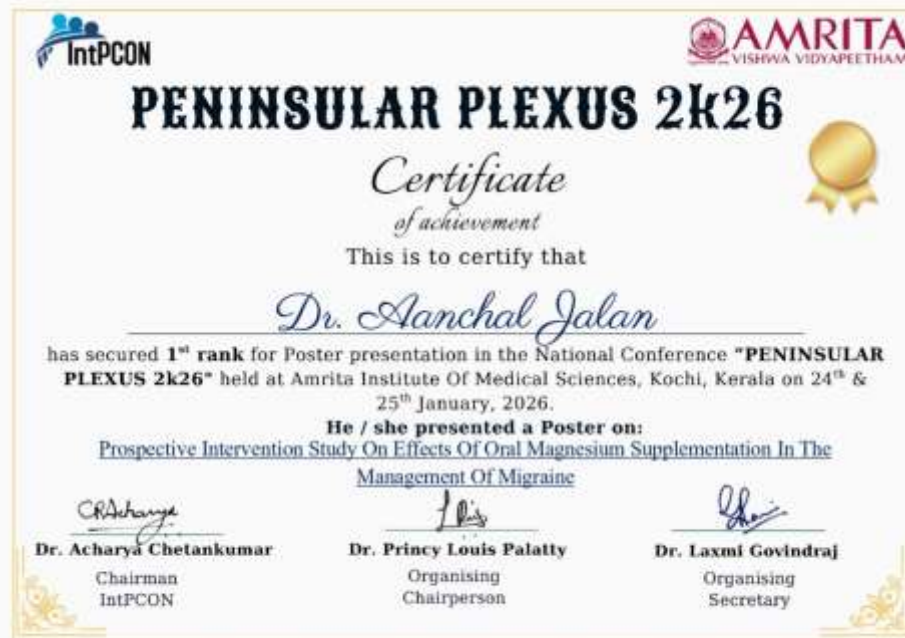

SILENT IMPOSTERS WHEN LUPUS CONCEALS THE PRESENCE OF MULTIPLE MYELOMA Author: Dr. SAI RISHITA RAYALA Guided by: Dr. R. Hegamam (HOD and Professor) Dr. Lakshmi Toppe Dr. Richa Sinha Department of general medicine, Mallareddy Medical College for Women, Hyderabad	4.62 year old male presented with bilateral foot pain, lower back pain, constipation and abdominal distension for 10 days. He also had intermittent fevers, decrease in urine output, nausea and vomiting, weakness and decrease in appetite. CT KID revealed multiple lytic lesions in spine, isotope post bilateral knee bones highly suggestive for Multiple myeloma or metastasis from carcinoma of prostate. PSA and urine for Bence Jones protein and SPEP were negative. Even though SPEP and UPEP were negative and increase in light chain could be confounded to renal disease, multiple in isotope was highly suggestive given his clinical investigations and imaging studies. Bone marrow aspiration and biopsy showed 88% of plasma cells consistent with multiple myeloma. PET CT confirmed the presence of multiple myeloma.	Labo: Later showed decrease in Hb/TdC and elevated serum creatinine, uric acid, ESR, LDH, uric acid and IgGkappa. Serum IgG kappa and lambda free light chains, serum Beta 2 Microglobulin levels are elevated. Serum immunofixation positive for kappa light. CT KID revealed multiple lytic lesions in spine, isotope and bilateral knee bones. PET CT revealed renally active, disorganized marrow and lytic lesions in the axial and appendicular skeleton with diffuse uptake noted in the cortex of kidneys.	Chemotherapy started with CyBorD (cyclophosphamide, bortezomib, doxorubicin) and was continued on supportive therapy. Patient's condition improved with prompt recovery of his symptoms and signs and is able to lead a normal active life.
INTRODUCTION	CLINICAL SIGNS	DISCUSSION	
Multiple Myeloma (MM) is a hematological malignancy characterized by uncontrolled proliferation of abnormal plasma cells causing destructive bone lesions, kidney failure, anemia and hypercalcemia. It involves 1% of all cancers and 13-15% of all hematological malignancies. It is also prevalent in males and the median age of occurrence is 65 years.	Physical examination revealed stable vital, distended abdomen and multiple small soft swellings on front and back of upper body suggestive of renal PKC of the swellings positive for multiple myeloma.	Multiple Myeloma is an incurable disease but highly treatable. Immunosuppressants of novel and emerging therapies to evade myeloma treatment burden have showed improvement in overall survival rate of 50% within the past decade. Early detection and timely intervention is seen to 10% percent can prevent devastating complications to multiple myeloma patients leading to improved quality of life and overall survival period.
